*Carpool Information

We are very excited to have a new way to sign-up for a carpool pick-up time. This new system will allow parents to select their own pick-up times and zones according to what is available. Parents will be able to see exactly how many pick-up time slots are available for each pick-up zone and can then choose the best time and zone for their family. Families will receive two carpool tags per household and can order additional tags for anyone else picking up students on a regular basis for \$2 each. All cars coming to pick up students will be assigned a carpool tag and number. When going on to register your vehicle, you will be asked to identify the make, model, color and license plate for each car. We are excited for the new carpool tags that are more durable and can be reused every year.

*Bus Information

Did you know that we offer bus service at Draper 2 & 3? Last year we piloted the bus program and many families found it worked really well. The bus starts picking up students about an hour before school, and leaves after the first Elementary dismissal time. Consider saving time during carpool by using the bus.

The cost is \$50 per month for each rider (morning and afternoon). To ride just one way, it costs \$25 per month. The great news - we offer maximum flexibility! You can pick the days and times that meet your family's needs, which will cost between \$5 and \$50 per month (for each student).
