We continue to mourn with the Moore family upon the loss of their sweet Rory. Rory had an inflamed appendix that leaked bacteria, causing sepsis. We are deeply grateful for the outpouring of love and support in her memory as students continue to fold paper cranes for her memorial exhibit at Draper 2. We chose cranes because of a popular heart-felt book called *Sadako and the Thousand Paper Cranes* about an Ancient Japanese legend that promises that anyone who folds a thousand origami cranes will be granted a wish by the crane god. The crane is a mystical and holy creature in Japan, and is said to live for 1,000 years so 1,000 cranes are made, one for each year. Our wish for the Moore family is peace, comfort and to feel our love.

We have also received many questions about how APA provides assistance to our families experiencing suffering or tragedy. We do this through our Friends of APA Hardship Fund. This fund was created to provide relief to staff, students, and families who may experience unexpected financial crises such as medical bills, unexpected death, loss of income, etc. We receive both individual donations and several fundraisers throughout the year also contribute to this worthy
