First Week of School

School begins at 8:00am (tardy bell rings at 8:05am) on Wednesday, August 16th. Doors will open at 7:30am. We are so excited to see our wonderful students! Please note that, since Wednesdays and Thursdays are earlier release days, 1st dismissal (Yellow) will begin at 2:15pm on the first day of school; 2nd dismissal (Blue) will begin at 2:30pm; and 3rd dismissal (Red) will begin at 2:45pm. During the 1st week of school Kindergarten will dismiss at 12:15pm on Aug 16-18, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. Kindergarten students enrolled in ½ day will dismiss att 11:30am. As we implement our initiative to assist students in becoming proficient with RISE, our 3:45pm (red) dismissal is reserved only for students participating in this special program. If your family is assigned 3:45pm (red) dismissal this means one or more of your students did not reach proficiency on these important end of year assessments. If you are not able to attend the Meet and Greet on Friday, you may check Skyward Friday afternoon for classroom/teacher assignments as well as dismissal times. You will need to make arrangements on Monday or Tuesday to pick up your family drop/off pick up tag for carpool.

Tips & Information for a Successful First Day of School

- Families with kindergarten students may park and walk their kindergarten students inside the building. If you choose to do this, we ask for you to wait until 8:15am to allow some of the parking lot to empty out. Please park in one of the visitor spots the numbered parking stalls are for our staff.
- As we have limited parking spaces, we ask that all other students be dropped off at the curb.
- When dropping off your student in the morning, always pull forward as far as possible before

unloading. Stay in your car and have your students get out on the curb side of the car. The line moves quickly when everyone follows these rules.

- On the 1st day of school all students will go directly to the homeroom class to be greeted by staff.
- In the afternoon, we encourage all parents to drive through the pick-up line to collect their students including kindergarten parents. The first few days are wonderful for establishing the routine of how pick-up will happen.

Walking Passes for Students

We are excited to be a part of your neighborhood and that you and your student(s) have the opportunity and convenience of walking to/from school. At APA, we are continually working to improve student safety so as to ensure we are one of the safest and most secure schools in Utah. To that end it is important that school safety procedures are followed and that parents provide informed consent and permission for releasing walking student(s).

Walking passes are issued to elementary students whose address is within 1.5 miles of the school.
