Whoever does not return their nametag on Friday, May 24th will be placed on our list to order and Skyward accounts will be updated reflecting a \$5 replacement fine.

Sixth grade students returning to seventh grade will be responsible for keeping their name tag and wearing it on the 1st day of school.
